JOB DESCRIPTION

Plant Title: Truck Driver
Department: Plantwide

Job Summary:

A current licensed driver with the ability to drive multiple types of trucks with automatic or manual transmissions. Has the ability to follow map directions. Possess the ability to secure loads carried on the truck.

Tools and Equipment:

Trucks equipped with automatic and manual transmissions, tie-down ratchets, bungee cords, rope, barrel dollies, and pallet jacks, hammer, vehicle jack, maps and atlases.

Source of Supervision:

Maintenance Supervisor, Superintendent, or other management personnel as necessary.

Working Procedures:

This position usually requires the employee to work with a minimal amount of supervision. The employee must possess a valid drivers license. Must be able to operate trucks with either an automatic or manual transmission. Must be able to take direction regarding where to travel, and what responsible party they are to contact when either dropping material off or picking material up. Must be able to determine weight of material loaded in the truck to remain under the gross vehicle weight. Must be able to secure material in the bed of the truck for proper transportation by utilizing bungee cords, ratchet tie-downs or rope. Must be able to sign for material received and have a responsible party sign for material delivered. Must be able to lift between zero to 50 lbs as needed and upon occasion up to 100 lbs. Must be able to sit, bend, twist, and operate both foot controls and hand controls while working. Follows all safety policies, plant policies, and wears the required personal protective equipment as required, (long pants, long sleeved shirts, safety glasses, gloves, metatarsal shoes, seat belt and other PPE as directed). Must be able to keeps truck clean and free of dirt. Must be able to maintain all fluids, air pressure and other materials as needed. Must be able to perform other tasks when not anticipated to drive as directed by the plant supervision.
